



## Corporate Group Volunteering Opportunities Summer Food Service Program—Help Feed Kids!

*Is your organization or business looking for a fun way to give back to the community and bond as a team this summer? This is the perfect opportunity for you!*

The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) was designed to ensure that kids get the healthy food they need when the school year ends. These free, healthy meals are available to kids and teens age 18 and under. The SFSP is funded by the United States Department of Agriculture, administered in Montana by the Office of Public Instruction School Nutrition Programs, and operated locally at organizations like schools, churches and community centers. The program is designed to give kids a safe place to hang out with friends, participate in fun activities and get a healthy meal. There's no paperwork; kids just need to show up. Volunteers are crucial to making these SFSP sites successful! If individuals in your group have specific talents or activities that they want to share with kids, that is great! If not, we can help you plan an activity to do with the kids (crafts, reading books, sports, etc.)



*There are 196 SFSP sites all over the state in various communities. Text "Lunch" to 877-877 to find the three Summer Meal Sites closest to you!*

Weekly volunteering is preferred. SFSP site hours vary, but you can find a time that works best for your group based on the site hours. One to two hours is sufficient. The only thing that you will need to do is schedule your group (organization and number of people), the activity/activities, and the day/time with the site supervisor. Then you can just show up with your group! It really is as easy as that!
